It has been stated from the beginning of the school year to "be mindful and courteous when dropping off/picking up your children from school as it is a busy time of day and we want everyone to be safe." We would like to remind you...

- **Fire Zone areas are *ONLY* to drop off or to quickly pick up a student.**
- **A vehicle is not to be left unattended, idling or parked in a Fire Zone.**
- **Please help children exit the car as quickly as possible. The student is to walk independently on the sidewalk towards the school entrance. The parent is to move their car along so as not to hold up traffic.**
- **Please understand that police may ticket vehicles that are parked in a Fire Zone or vehicles that are left unattended in a Fire Zone.**
- **Parking is limited. If you would like to visit with other parents and/or stay with your child until the bell rings, please park in a permitted parking spot.**
