SCHOOL BUS



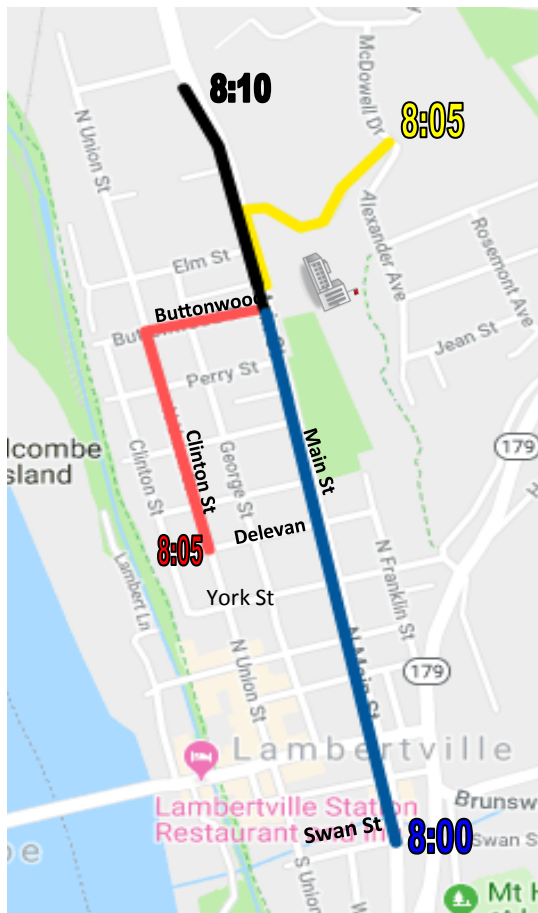
Lambertville is starting up the "Walking School Buses." The Walking School Bus is a group of students, chaperoned by adults, who walk a regular route to school once a week.

The "buses" start at selected locations and students are "picked up" along the way.

Walking as a group is fun, provides exercise and benefits the environment if the students would otherwise be driven.



Four routes are being offered this fall. They will begin at the locations and times listed below.



Students are encouraged to walk to school everyday, however the Walking School Bus Program only takes place on Tuesdays.

Pick up times vary by route. Please note: Walking School Buses will be dependent on the weather.

If you are interested in having your child join a Walking School Bus, contact the chaperone for your route. The Walking School Buses will operate on Tuesdays, on the way to school only.

If you live too far from the school, contact the chaperone and arrange a place to drop your child off along the route.

Caught Being Safe Program

On Walking School Bus Tuesday's students have the opportunity to earn a "Caught Being Safe" Ticket. Students who display exceptional safe pedestrian behavior can be awarded a ticket by either the walking school bus drivers, the school crossing guard, or safety patrol members. Each ticket can be redeemed for a prize.
